#### THE LORD'S SUPPER

We celebrate the sacrament of the Lord's Supper at the beginning of each month. We believe the Bible clearly describes who should, and who should not, participate. To guide you, we have developed a list of five questions to consider. If you are able to say "yes" to the following questions, you are welcome to join us:

#### 1. Have I publicly professed Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord? (Romans 10:9-10)

Jesus Christ is the only Savior for sinners, through his death represented in the Lord's Supper. Jesus Christ is the only Lord over our lives. Please participate only if you have publicly professed your belief in these truths.

## 2. Have I been baptized in the Name of Jesus Christ? (Acts 2:38)

The sacrament of baptism should come before the sacrament of the Lord's Supper. We believe baptism is appropriate for infants or adults, whether done by sprinkling, pouring, or immersion, as long as it is done in the Name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

#### 3. Am I taking the sacrament in a spirit of unity? (1 Corinthians 11)

Jesus spoke of the importance of resolving conflicts before worship, and Paul warned against disunity in the early church. Before you eat and drink, you should do all you can to reconcile with other believers in Jesus Christ.

### 3. Do I understand the nature of the Sacrament? (1 Corinthians 11)

The Lord's Supper uses visible elements to represent spiritual truths. The bread represents the body of Jesus Christ, and the cup represents the blood of Jesus Christ. While the bread and the cup do not change into the physical body and blood of Jesus Christ, we believe Jesus Christ is spiritually present with us, as we eat and drink the sacrament. Please note: We use both wine (in colored cups) and grape juice (in clear cups) for Communion.

### 4. Am I free of Biblical church discipline? (Matthew 18:15-17)

Sometimes churches will tell their members not to participate in the Lord's Supper because of unresolved sin. If you have received such discipline through a biblical process, please do not participate with us until you have been reconciled with your church.
