Martin Luther: Of the Lord's Supper

Leader: Now this is the fruit, that even as we have eaten and drunk the body and blood of Christ the Lord, we in turn, permit ourselves to be eaten and drunk, and say the same words to our neighbor, 'Take, eat and drink'...These are the words [Christ] speaks to us; these we must take, and repeat them to our neighbor, not by the mouth alone, but by our actions, saying...
