Confession of Faith

Heidelberg Catechism 12, 13, 15, 18

Leader: According to God's righteous judgement we deserve punishment both now and in eternity: how then can we escape this punishment and return to God's favor?

Congregation: God requires that His justice be satisfied. Therefore the claims of this justice must be paid in full, either by ourselves or by another. *Leader: Can we make this payment ourselves?* 

Congregation: Certainly not. Actually, we increase our debt every day. Leader: What kind of mediator and deliverer should we look for then? Congregation: One who is a true and righteous human, yet more powerful than all creatures, that is, one who is also true God. Leader: Then who is this mediator?

Everyone: Our Lord Jesus Christ, who was given to us to completely deliver us and make us right with God.
